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David Emler, Ph.D., has been a faculty member at the *Institute of International Studies, Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University*, since 2009, where he teaches and conducts research as an Assistant Professor. His academic interests focus on contemporary French history and politics, as well as the cultural history of Central Europe.

Since 2022, he has served as Vice-Dean for Faculty Development, and in 2024 he assumed the role of Director of the *Supply Chain Resilience Center (SCRC)*, a collaborative research consortium established between *National Chengchi University (NCCU)* and *Charles University*. In 2025, he became a member of the Scientific Council of the *French Research Center in Humanities and Social Sciences (CEFRES)*.
